Course Number 04-2003: Tactical Carbine- Train the trainer (Patrol Rifle Instructors Course)

Course Description: With the addition of more tactical carbines into the urban law enforcement environment, the requirement of local Law Enforcement agencies to train it's officers is increasing. This course will focus on training the Department's internal training sources in the area of Tactical Carbine. The course format is unique to C4i Services but is modeled on the NRA Patrol Rifle Instructor course. Upon completion of this period of instruction, the graduate will be able to train officers in his/her department in the use of the tactical carbine in the urban environment.

A training manual will be provided to each student upon completion of the course.

Course Duration: Tactical Carbine- Train the trainer is a three day period of instruction.

Intended Audience: The course is designed for Police Department training officers and first line supervisors that are responsible for training their own personnel.

Training Location: Training is conducted at the unit's designated training area.

References: Primary instructors for this course have instructed, instructors for such organizations as Strategic Shooting International, Blackwater Academy, and the Department of the Navy. Primary instructors are NRA/ LE certified instructors.
